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Worker Protection Standard BASIC Pesticide Safety Information Acknowledgement (Workers)

I, _____ have received the following basic pesticide safety information before entering any areas treated with pesticide:

- Pesticides may be on or in plants, soil, irrigation water, or drifting from nearby applications.

As an agricultural worker, I may prevent pesticides from entering my body by:

- Following directions or signs, or both, about keeping out of a treated or restricted areas;
- Washing before eating, drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco products, or using the toilet;
- Wearing work clothing that protects the body from pesticide residue;
- Washing or showering with soap and water, shampooing hair, and putting on clean clothing after work;
- Washing work clothes separately from other clothes before wearing; and
- Washing immediately in the nearest clean water if pesticides are spilled or sprayed on the body, and as soon as possible, showering, shampooing, and changing into clean clothes.
